When to Visit the Emergency Department

There are times when the need for emergency care is not clear. When in doubt, do not hesitate to seek medical attention, as it is always better to receive an examination than to ignore a potential problem. If you or a loved one experiences any of the eight symptoms below, emergency care should be sought immediately.

- Chest pain, upper abdominal pain or pressure
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Fainting or feeling faint
- Dizziness, sudden weakness or sudden change in vision
- Severe pain anywhere in the body
- Severe or persistent vomiting
- Suicidal or homicidal feelings
- Uncontrollable bleeding

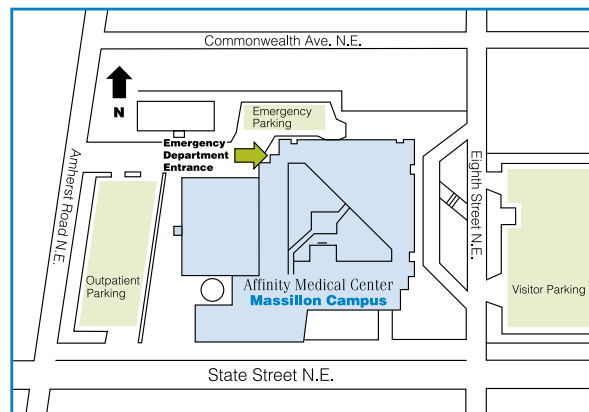
