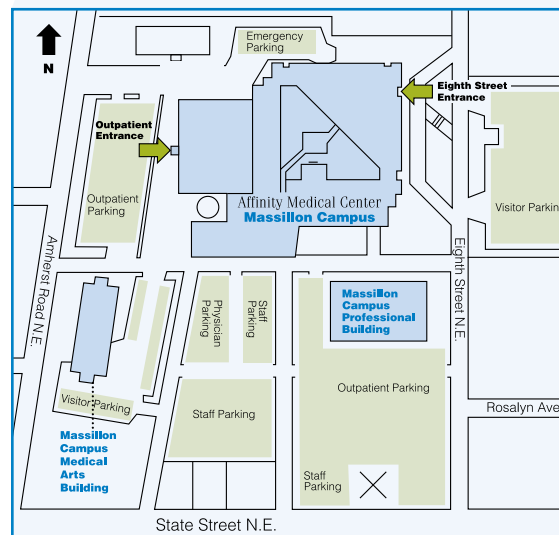
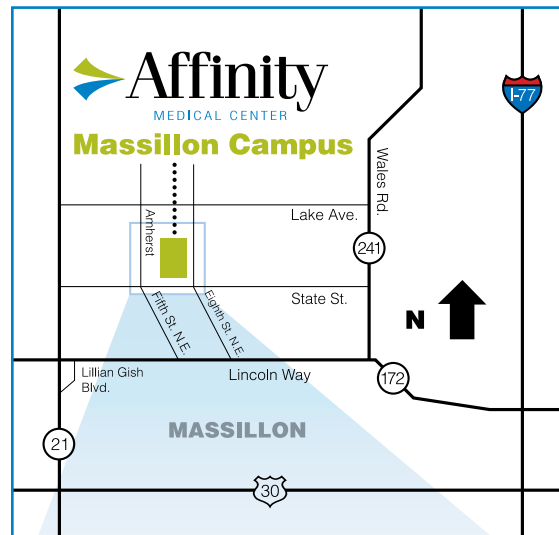


The Healing Process

Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy

Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (HBO) therapy is a painless procedure where qualifying patients breathe pure oxygen. Usually administered daily, this therapy floods the bloodstream with oxygen, helping to kill bacteria and improve circulation.

Uses for HBO therapy include the treatment of diabetic lower extremity ulcers, difficult-to-heal surgical wounds, skin grafts, radiation bone damage, radiation soft-tissue damage, gangrene, osteomyelitis, and crush injuries.

Your Role in Healing

You play a large role in the success of your treatment. Carefully following directions and closely monitoring your progress is critical to a faster recovery.

We will show you how to care for your wound at home, including how to change dressings and protect yourself from further injury. We will always be here to answer your questions and provide the support you need to heal.

- Current list of allergies and reactions
